Title:	Resident Carillonist
Purpose:	To provide carillon music at GPMC
Supervision:	The Resident Carillonist is under the direct supervision of the Minister of Music
Status:	Part-time (10 hours per month)
Evaluation:	Performance evaluations will be performed by the Minister of Music

Education, Experience and Skills Required:

- Undergraduate degree with music emphasis preferred
- Carillon playing experience and ability
- Ability to communicate and work with diverse personalities and ages
- Understanding and support of the mission of GPMC

Responsibilities:

- Playing the GPMC carillon before and after Sunday morning service twice per month
- Overseeing and promoting the volunteer carillonneur program
- Private lessons with new carillon students (with additional remuneration)
- Coordinating the summer recital series
- Wedding and memorial services when requested (with additional remuneration)
- The typical schedule for this position is
 - Two Sundays per month 8:30 am – 12:15 pm
 - Practice and preparation at the discretion of the employee

Physical Demands:

- Excellent vision and hearing
- Ability to climb stairs (to carillon tower)
